Notes: This cemetery was read by Susan Hunter. Location: Section 2, Township 5N, Range 2W. Driving directions: Traveling from State Route 7, at the north end of Rayland, take State Route 150 Rayland/Dillonvale Exit. At the first stop sign make a left. At the second stop sign make a right onto State Rute 150, west. Travel 0.5 miles and make a right onto County Road 15. Travel approx. 3.5 miles and turn right onto County Road 16. This splits off, make the left onto County Road 4, Travel approx. 0.5 mile and make a right onto a gravel driveway. Go straight, the cemetery is behind the house in the woods. Private Property.

James and George Beall purchased the property where the Beall family cemetery is located in 1807. The following cemetery has many stones that are broken and unreadable. Approximately sixteen stones were found. Beall Cemetery is located in Section 14 of Warren Twp near the Hopewell Cemetery which is located in Section 20 of Warren Twp.
