The Renforths own the property as of 2008. They gave Tammy and Terry Hosenfeld, John E. Borkowski and Flora L. VerStraten permission to probe and restore cemetery. This was done in the spring of 2007. The owners were surprised that the group were able to locate tombstones buried in the ground. The tombstones were epoxied, reset and restored. This cemetery sits on the side of the road and is mowed and cared for by the property owners. This cemetery is on private property and any visitors should seek permission from the owners to enter.

History: William D. and Eleanora (Hyndman) Fell (buried at New Alexandria Cemetery) may have been parents of Roxie Fell. In our earlier tombstone inscription book, by Esther Powell, she states, "records of Jefferson County Ohio, Aaron Fell early to this township. Had ch: Wm. D., Thomas B., An and Sarah (married David Armstrong). William D. born 1841, married Eleanora Hyndman, d/o James and Eleanora (Presberry) Hyndman; had 8 children: James & E. Hyndman had: Hannah (Dean), James, Sophia (Davis), Eliz (Langley), Rachel (Melvin), Geo. Eleanor (Fell), Edward, Ophelia (married Jas. Thompson & Martha (married O. M. Waddle).
