Pioneer Family applicant must prove residence by Dec 31, 1850.

A one time application fee of \$15.00 covering as many ancestors as the applicant wishes to prove, sufficient proof of descent, must be submitted; and a five generation chart, showing the name(s) of every ancestor claimed is optional.


